Content

The content of Site Specific programs, both theory and practical components, are developed to address the unique requirements of your organisation. This may include:

- detailed instruction in organisation fleet policy and procedures
- management of fatigue
- correct operation and maintenance of company vehicles
- correct selection and operation of 4WD functions
- practical on road hazard perception and risk awareness
- braking techniques
- correct vehicle set-up (mirrors, seats etc) and shutdown procedures
- space management principles
- observation techniques and strategies
- perform vehicle safety checks
- responsibly sharing the road with other road users
- safe vehicle manoeuvring going forward and in reverse
- basic vehicle recovery
- ascent and descent control
- water crossings
- driving on various road surfaces
