








Most Queenslanders are concerned about being impacted by severe storms or flooding this spring/summer 53% of Queenslanders have not been personally affected by a severe weather event

Most Queenslanders state they live in or close to areas affected by storms and cyclones








SS1. To what extent are you concerned about being impacted by severe storms or flooding this spring/summer? SS3. Have you event?

SS10. Have you completed any retrofits or made changes to your home to make it more resilient in severe weather events?








#### Common behaviours when preparing for storm season

### 3% of people don't prepare for storm season


The majority of which either don't believe they need to prepare or don't live in an area impacted by storms.\*


## After storm damage, what would you do while waiting for insurance assistance?




