Value for money and improved cost of living

We will advocate for:

- Consumer advocacy around cost of living in fuel, cars, transport, finance, water and energy
- Equitable access to transport and mobility options for all
- Financial literacy to improve the lives of all Queenslanders
- Affordable and accessible banking and insurance products and services
- Affordable access to sustainable transport options including ultra-low emission vehicles
- Fair and justifiable motoring and mobility costs whether imposed by industry or government

We will advocate for:

- Ensure mobility options contribute to the environmental sustainability of Queensland and reduce congestion
- Community sustainability through improved access to reliable and renewable energy and water supply
- Active involvement in mitigating climate risk on the Queensland community
